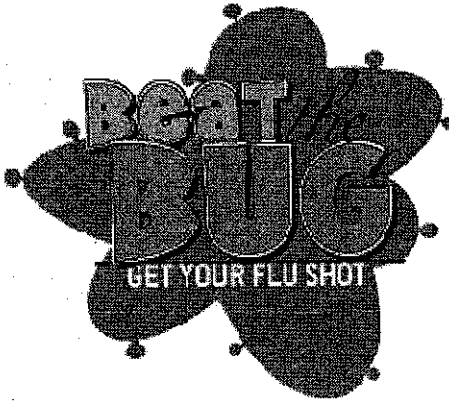

Shoo the Flu & Pneumonia Too!!

Once again, Front Range Flu Shots, LLC, will be providing flu & pneumococcal immunization here at the Town Hall.

FRONT RANGE FLU SHOTS' POLICIES & INSURANCE COVERAGE:

Flu Shot

- Age Policy: Must be 4 years or older to receive a flu shot
- Insurance: No cost for those covered by the following insurance plans:
Medicare Part B or Railroad Medicare Part B (if they are your primary insurance plan), Humana (except Humana One & PDP), Rocky Mountain Health Plans, Secure Horizons, or Sloans Lake/Cofinity. Insurance card must be presented

Pneumococcal Shot:

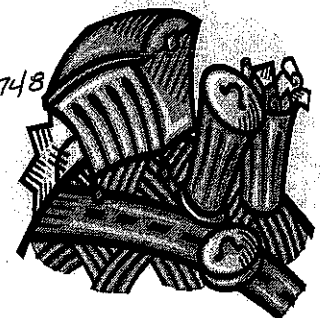
- Age Policy: Must be 18 years old or older to receive a pneumonia shot
- Insurance: If Medicare Part B or Railroad Medicare Part B is your primary insurance, or you have Sloans Lake/Cofinity insurance, ask the nurse if you are eligible for a pneumococcal shot at no cost when an insurance card is presented

*FluMist Nasal Spray (upon availability)

- Age Policy: FluMist is available to healthy individuals ages 4-49 years old who are not pregnant

Annual Fall Clean-up

The annual fall "dumpsters" will be brought in at noon Thursday, October 22 & picked up at noon Saturday, October 24. **THEY WILL NOT BE AT THE COUNTRY CLUB POOL OR BURNING TREE POOL, THEY WILL BE PLACED IN THE TOWN HALL PARKING LOT.** Remember, **NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.** Many common products found in your home such as oil-based paint, mercury, gasoline, de-greaser, cleaning compounds & garden chemicals may be hazardous & should be disposed of properly. You may call Arapahoe County Disposal Service at ~~(303) 795-3834~~ ³⁷⁴⁸ for more information. **Please do not put electronics, refrigerators, or other major appliances in or around the dumpsters.** Please call the Town office for these items, we have a recycler who will take most anything away you no longer need. The Town office will be the collection site but please call first to ensure the items you have are eligible for this program.



DISPOSAL FOR VEHICLE BATTERIES, TIRES & OIL



Tires, car batteries (lead-acid batteries) should never be disposed of in your home trash container or dumpster, or poured into any type of drain. These materials can be easily recycled instead. Most automotive shops & stores (Checker Auto Parts or Pep Boys) accept car batteries & used motor oil for recycling at no charge. Car tires may be recycled at tire shops when you purchase new tires.

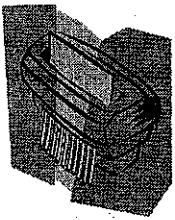

Effective December 1, 2009, there will be a new law which states drivers under 18 years of age are prohibited from using their cell phones while in a vehicle, unless parked. There are exceptions for emergencies. No driver, regardless of age, may "text".

Shredding Project



There will be an on-site shredding service in the Town Hall parking lot on Saturday, November 7, 2009, from 9 am to 12 pm. Residents may bring any documents & records they would like destroyed safely & can witness their destruction. Unacceptable items are vinyl notebooks, phone books, newspapers & hard back books. They will destroy/shred CD's, DVD's, hard drives, floppies & video's but can only perform this service off site, where the owner of the shredding company witnesses all destruction. It is required that all such material be kept separate from the paper when brought to the Town Hall.

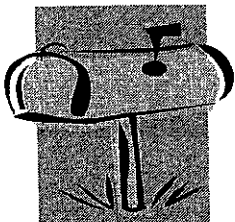
All shredded paper will be recycled in an environmentally friendly manner
