



FALL CLEANUP

The dumpsters will be brought in at noon Thursday, October 24th, and picked up at noon Saturday, October 26th. They will be placed in the Town Hall parking lot. No landscape materials and **NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS** allowed. Many common products found in your home such as oil-based paint, mercury, gasoline, de-greaser, cleaning compounds and garden chemicals may be hazardous and should be disposed of properly. You may call Arapahoe County Disposal Service at (303) 795-3834 for more information.

Please do not put electronics, refrigerators or other major appliances in the dumpsters. The Town will have a recycler who will be around the dumpsters to take away any of these items you want to get rid of. He will also take away these items throughout the year. The Town office will be the collection site but please call first to ensure the items you have are eligible for this program.

DISPOSAL FOR VEHICLE BATTERIES, TIRES AND OIL: Tires, car batteries (lead-acid batteries) should never be disposed of in your home trash container or dumpster, or poured into any type of drain. These materials can be easily recycled instead. Most automotive shops and stores (Checker Auto Parts or Pep Boys) accept car batteries and used motor oil for recycling at no charge. Car tires may be recycled at tire shops when you purchase new tires.

DISPOSAL OF LATEX PAINT: Latex paint is NOT a hazardous waste, and can be safely disposed of with your regular household garbage once it is dried out and no longer liquid. To dry latex paint, remove the lid from the paint cans, mix in an absorbent to speed the drying process (such as kitty litter, dirt or sand) and allow the paint to dry completely before disposing with your regular trash pickup.

TRASH AND RECYCLE

Please remember not to bring your trash or recycle to the curb until the night before pick-up (Monday morning unless Monday is a holiday). Also be sure to keep trash cans covered with lids.

The Town's trash provider, Republic Waste Services, has large, 96 gallon, wheeled-recycle bins available to residents who would like them. If you would like a larger bin, call Town Hall at 303-795-1434 and we will arrange for delivery



Please be mindful of other people's property and pick up after your dog. Please take any deposits left by your pet to your own trash.
