February 21, 2023

Mayor Palmer called the Regular Meeting of the Trustees to order at 6:30 p.m., in the Conference Room at the Town Hall at 2 Middlefield Road, Columbine Valley, Colorado. Roll call found the following present:

#### PUBLIC COMMENT: There was no public comment.

Jason Murphy, Columbine Country Club GM provided the trustees with a brief review of Club happenings.

#### **CONSENT AGENDA:**

ACTION: upon a motion by Trustee Tarpey and a second by Trustee Giesen, the Board of Trustees unanimously approved the consent agenda as presented.

#### REPORTS

- A. Mayor Palmer had no report.
- **B.** Trustee Boyle mentioned that she was getting underway with her special projects for the year; Trustee Dotson shared that Bank of the West, the Town's primary bank, had been sold to the Bank of Montreal.
- C. Mrs. Rodriguez reviewed the January financials as presented in the Trustees Packet.
- **D.** Mr. McCrumb reviewed his report as presented in the Trustees Packet. Mr. Kaslon presented a development update.
- E. Chief Cottrell reviewed the report as presented in the Trustee Packet.

#### **PRESENTATIONS**

- A. Mile High Flood District: Reynolds Landing Mr. Skuodas presented to the Trustees the plans for Reynolds Landing. The Trustees asked clarifying questions.
- B. Town Traffic Considerations Mr. McCrumb and Chief Cottrell presented the Trustees with their findings and recommendations related to traffic safety and control in Town. The Trustees directed staff to install a pilot-program, lighted stop sign at Village Drive and Middlefield to see if it would reduce stop sign blow through. The Trustees will review the results in one year. Additionally, the Trustees discussed Town speed limits. Staff will bring in an expert Traffic Engineer to advise the Trustees on the options moving forward.

#### OLD BUSINESS

A. Public Hearing on Trustee Bill #1-2023: Mayor Palmer opened the public hearing at 7:23. Mr. Kaslon presented the ordinance.

Mara Marks, 8 Driver Lane asked the Trustees to consider enforcement, standards, and communication of the ordinance.

There being no additional public comment the hearing was closed at 7:35.

**B.** Trustee Bill #1-2023 – Right of Way: Mr. Kaslon and Mr. Schiller presented this ordinance to the Trustees. The Trustees asked clarifying questions. The Trustees directed staff to clarify the language relating to pre-existing conditions.

ACTION: no action was taken. The Trustees tabled the ordinance until a future meeting.

C. Trustee Bill #2-2023 – Virtual Meeting/Voting: Mr. Schiller presented this ordinance to the Trustees. They asked clarifying questions.

ACTION: upon a motion by Trustee Icenogle and a second by Trustee Timothy the Board of Trustees passed the ordinance as presented on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading.

**ADJOURNMENT:** There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:54 p.m.

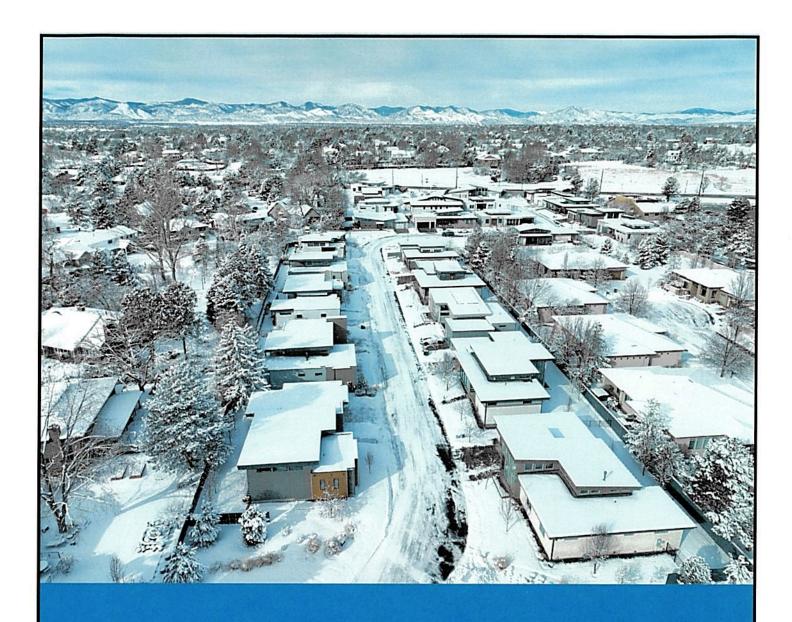

#### Communications & Administration

- The Town was not selected for Safe Route to School grant funding for the sidewalk along Platte Canyon Road. A second grant is being pursued.
- Staff is beginning the process of updating our bid process to realign it with best practices and state standards.
- An IGA with Arapahoe County which would allow the Town to conduct de-icing operations on Platte Canyon Road is currently under review by the Town's insurance provider. While not likely to be in place this season, it's implementation will be useful in the future.

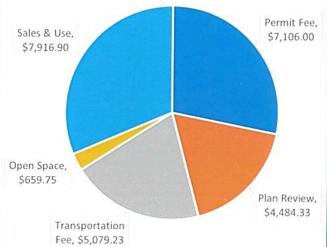

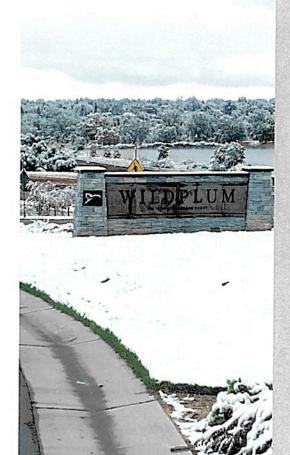

#### **Public Works Department**

- Town Hall updates: A large lighting update was performed. A set of new lights were installed over the reception area, replacing the original ones that were falling down. Many bad ballasts in the staff office areas were replaced. Cracked light covers were replaced along with a damaged parking lot bollard light. The garbage disposal was also replaced.
- Ice removal: With an uncommon weather pattern in February of daily freeze/thaw, ice was a much larger issue than normal. There were many days of spreading salt town-wide before both morning and evening rush hours. Multiple areas around town developed ice dams that had to be manually broken up and removed to allow the melting snow to make it to the stormwater inlets. The hill leading up Coal Mine from Platte Canyon was also salted multiple times at the request of recue workers to try to prevent cars from sliding into each other or the intersection.
- Wild Plum: We are continuing to provide feedback on the emergency access project as more information is provided to the Town. The new estimated approval date for a building permit is mid April.

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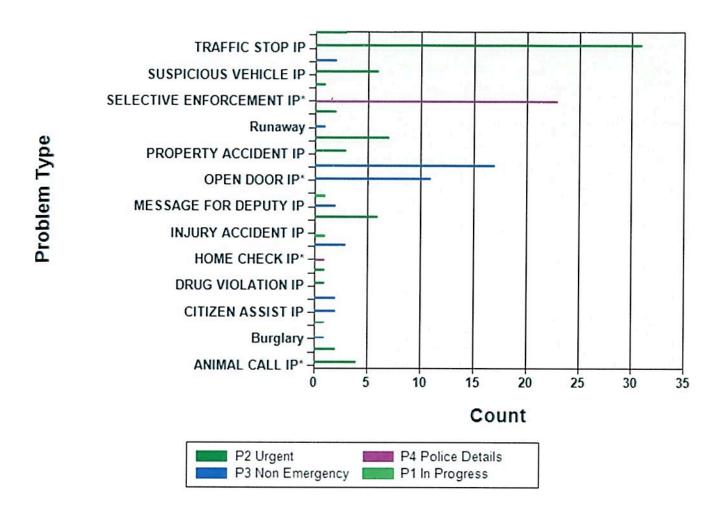
