CONCERNING

THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN
OF COLUMBINE VALLEY, COLORADO:

Section 1: Section 10.08.030 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

10.08.030 Golf cart operation on roadway

A. Only a licensed driver may operate a golf cart on the roadway of a street in the Town except as follows:

1. An unlicensed driver, who is 8 years of age or older, may operate a golf cart, on the roadway of a street in the Town, when accompanied by a licensed driver or a person who is 21 years of age or older.

2. An unlicensed driver may operate a golf cart upon lands owned or leased by his parent or guardian.

B. While being operated on a roadway of a street in the Town, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, such golf cart shall be equipped with at least two front headlights emitting a white light visible from a distance of at least five hundred feet to the front as well as two tail lights visible from a distance of five hundred feet.

C. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 10.04.030 of the Municipal Code.


Section 2: That should any section, clause, sentence, part or portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by any Court to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect, impair or invalidate the ordinance as a whole or any part hereof other than the part or portion declared by such Court to be unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 3: The Town Clerk shall certify the passage of this Ordinance and cause notice of its contents and passage to be published.


Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of thirty (30) days after the publication of this Ordinance in the Littleton Independent, Littleton, Colorado, said newspaper being a weekly newspaper duly qualified for publishing legal notices and

advertisements within the meaning of the laws of the State of Colorado.

Introduced as Trustee Bill No. 2, series of 2010, at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Columbine Valley, held at The Town of Columbine Valley Town Hall, 2 Middlefield Road, Columbine Valley, Arapahoe County, Colorado, on the 16th day of February, 2010, passed by a vote of 7 for and 0 against on first reading; passed by the Board of Trustees on second reading, at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held at the Columbine Valley Town Hall, Arapahoe County, Colorado, by a vote of 5 for and 0 against on the 16th day of March, 2010, at 6:30 P.M. and ordered published in the Littleton Independent on the 1st day of April, 2010.
