

30-Day Temporary Permit Application: Dumpster, Storage Container, or Portable Toilet

When a building permit is not required for a project, a property owner may apply for a temporary permit for a dumpster, storage container, or portable toilet. Complete a separate form for each type of unit you need and email it to <u>bzapata-diaz@columbinevalley.org</u>.

- The property owner must obtain a cost-free permit from the Town.
- The unit must remain on private property.*
- The unit is only permitted to be on site for 30 days or less.
- The unit must be removed from the site on or before the permit expiration date.

*The Columbine Valley Municipal Code prohibits temporary dumpsters, storage units, and portable toilets anywhere within the Town's right-of-way. Any use or application of these units for private use must remain on an individual's private property.
