The Building department manages contractor licenses and building permits for the Towns of Columbine Valley and Bow Mar. The Town reviews construction plans, issues licenses and permits, and manages building inspections. Note that HOAs often require separate approvals as well.

The Police department serves the Towns of Columbine Valley and Bow Mar, responding to calls for service, conducting follow-up investigations, and enforcing federal and state laws along with municipal ordinances. The police monitor parking regulations, enforce traffic regulations for personal vehicles and golf carts, and offer a House Watch service.
