

#### **Public Works Updates**

#### Town Hall Electrical

Public Works handled an electrical issue at Town Hall:

- Multiple outlets on the main floor were no longer functional.
- After tracing multiple lines through the building, Public Works determined there was a failure in the breaker box.
- After the issue was repaired, power was restored to all of the circuits.

#### Water Lateral

Public Works handled an issue caused by the spring rainstorms:

- A section of the irrigation lateral from the Nevada Ditch became partially clogged.
- The clog caused a backup in the system, spilling water out into the stormwater system along Eagle Drive.
- Proper flow has been restored.

#### Wild Plum Punch List

In an effort to help wrap up the development of Wild Plum, Public Works compiled a comprehensive punch list. This 126-page document details all of the major damage, errors, and failures that occurred during the infrastructure construction that still need to be fixed. Once all of the punch list items have been addressed, the probationary acceptance process can continue.




#### Wild Plum Concrete Update
